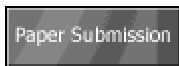

Submission of Papers

ACM SIGCOMM Asia workshop 2005 requires that papers be not submitted simultaneously to any other conference or publication and that submissions be not previously published. Authors of accepted papers need to sign an ACM copyright release form. Electronic copies of the camera-ready papers will be published on the conference website before the conference, unless authors specifically request otherwise. Full papers should be written in English and in PDF format, with no more than 20 pages, double space, 12pt, including figures. Papers should be submitted through the EDAS website:
